## CATHERINE BEACH KERR

Catherine Kerr, widow of John Kerr, passed away at South Cumberland Memorial Hospital, Parrsboro, on Tuesday, November 14. Mrs. Kerr, who had recently moved into one of the units of Parrsboro's new housing complex, had been in hospital just a few days.

The late Mrs. Kerr was born in Port Greville 86 years ago, the daughter of the late Florence Hatfield and Isaac Beach. She lived most of her life in this area. She is survived by a daughter, Florence (Mrs. Everett Canning), of Parrsboro; a son, Percy Kerr, Port Greville; and two grandchildren: Kerr Canning, Dartmouth, and Catherine (Mrs. Leo Robins), Calgary. Her husband predeceased her in 1967.

The funeral service was held at Holy Trinity Anglican Church, Fox River, on Thursday, November 16, at 3 p.m., with the Rev. W. S. Wagner officiating.
